Discussion Questions:

3. What does Pastor Furtick mean when he speaks of the Resurrection as the “greatest sabotage in history”?
4. Pastor Furtick said, “The salvation of God can only begin where your human striving ends.” What does it look like to attempt to earn your salvation? Why is this effort such a common practice?
